The subject aims to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the fundamental concepts, techniques, and applications of textile design and embroidery. The subject aims to teach students about the various types of textiles, including their characteristics, properties, and applications.

**Project - Print Design Development** 

### **GARMENT CONSTRUCTION AND DRAFTING -I**
